Direct object pronouns

- **Direct object pronouns** can go before the conjugated verb or be attached to the end of an infinitive.

¿Ya conoces **la ciudad**?

Do you already know the city?

No, todavía no **la** conozco.

No, I don't know it yet.

¿Quieres recorrer**la**
conmigo?

*Do you want to tour it with
me?*

Pronouns with command forms

- In affirmative commands, attach the **pronoun** to the end of the verb.
- Don't forget to add an accent mark when needed.
- In negative commands, place the **pronoun** before the conjugated verb.

Lláma**me** después de tu viaje, pero no **me** llames muy tarde.

Call me after your trip, but don't call me very late.
